SC notice to TN, Ktk on threat to HC judges over hijab verdict

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Wednesday sought a response from the Tamil Nadu government and others on a plea filed by a man, who allegedly issued death threats to the three Karnataka High Court judges, following their verdict on the hijab issue, seeking to quash or transfer the second FIR filed against him in Karnataka. A bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and Bela M Trivedi issued notices to Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and others while seeking their responses before May 18.

Provide diesel to KSRTC at retail rates: Kerala HC to oil Cos

KOCHI: The Kerala High Court on Wednesday asked the State-run oil marketing companies to provide diesel to the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation buses at retail rates and not the higher rate being charged from bulk purchasers. The interim order by Justice N Nagesh came on a plea by KSRTC challenging the OMCs decision to charge a higher rate from bulk purchasers of diesel as compared to retail prices of the fuel.

Inter-faith marriage sparks political row in Kerala

KOZHIKODE: A recent interfaith marriage of a Muslim activist of the ruling CPI(M)'s youth wing DYFI, has stirred up a political storm after the relatives of the Christian bride alleged "love jihad", with a senior left party leader supporting the charge, only to retract his statement later. As the issue snowballed into a major controversy, the Marxist party on Wednesday made it clear that there was nothing unorthodox in interfaith marriages and the campaign of 'love jihad' was a creation of RSS and Sangh Parivar.

KOTTAYAM (Kerala), Apr 13 (PTI) Former Kerala Health Minister M P Govindan Nair died here on Wednesday morning. He was 96. Nair died of age-related ailments at his residence here, family sources said.

Orange alert in Idukki district amidst heavy rain in Kerala

IDUKKI: The Central Meteorological Department (CMD) on Wednesday issued an orange alert in Idukki district of Kerala amidst heavy rain in the State. The CMD predicts very heavy rainfall of 115.6 mm to 204.4 mm in 24 hours in the district. The State has been receiving moderate to heavy rainfall in various parts over the last one week or so. The CMD predicts heavy rains due to the impact of a cyclone which formed off the southern coast of Tamil Nadu.

Hiked bus, taxi fares to come from May 1: Kerala Minister

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: From next month onwards the general public will have to shell out more for travel by bus, auto or taxi with state Transport Minister Antony Raju on Wednesday announcing that the recently increased fares would come into effect from May 1. Raju said requisite orders would be issued soon for implementing the hiked fares from next month.

TN declares Ambedkar birth anniversary as 'Equality Day'

CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin on Wednesday announced in the Assembly that the birth anniversary of Dr B R Ambedkar on April 14 would be celebrated as 'Equality Day' from this year onwards. Making a statement in the House, Stalin said a pledge would also be taken across the state on that day.

Our Telangana leaders have shown CM right direction: BJP

NEW DELHI: The BJP on Wednesday said its announcement of procuring grains from Telangana farmers over and above the central procurement if it forms government in the state prompted the incumbent TRS dispensation to decide on purchasing paddy stock from farmers. The party also said it winning power in Telangana is "imminent".

TG CS talks with Collectors on paddy procurement

HYDERABAD: With the Telangana government deciding to procure the entire paddy produced by the farmers this rabi season, state Chief Secretary Somesh Kumar held a teleconference with District Collectors and other officials concerned on Wednesday and took stock of the situation in the respective districts. The meeting comes a day after CM Chandrababhan Nao announced that his government will procure entire commodity from the state's farmers by opening procurement centres on war-footing.

ED arrests Ker leader MK Ashraf

NEW DELHI: The Enforcement Directorate has arrested MK Ashraf, a Popular Front of India leader from Kerala, under the PMLA. He was arrested at the Delhi Headquarters of the federal agency yesterday, sources said. PFI leader's residence was raided by the ED last January and subsequently, he was summoned multiple times to Delhi for questioning.

Raj doing BJP's bidding: Pawar

SAYS HIS SPEECH bereft of common man's issues

MUMBAI

NCP chief Sharad Pawar on Wednesday alleged that Raj Thackeray is doing the BJP's bidding, a day after the MNS president batted for the Uniform Civil Code and stressed the need for controlling population growth in the country. Queried about Raj Thackeray's ultimatum to the state government to remove loudspeakers from mosques till May 3, Pawar said, "the government will think over it seriously", but didn't elaborate. He also dismissed Raj Thackeray's allegation that

he (Pawar) is an atheist. "I go to temples but don't believe in showing off," the NCP chief told reporters. Pawar said his ideals include activist Prabodhankar Thackeray (Raj Thackeray's grandfather), who opposed the people trying to profit themselves in the name of gods and religions. "He (Prabodhankar Thackeray) did not disrespect (gods and religion), but he criticised those who took disadvantage of it. We people read the writings of Prabodhankar, but some in his family may not be reading it," Pawar said in a dig at the



MNS chief. Pawar also alleged that attempts are being made to disturb the social unity in Maharashtra and communal ideology is being promoted in the state. Addressing a Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) rally in Thane on Tuesday night, Raj Thackeray had said that if the Shiv Sena-led state government did not remove the high-decibel loudspeakers from mosques before May 3, MNS workers will play the Hanuman Chalisa in front of mosques. "It is obvious that we got to hear through his (Raj Thackeray's) speech what the BJP

guided him," Pawar said. He said the MNS chief did not utter a single word about the BJP but targeted the Nationalist Congress Party - a key constituent in the tripartite Maha Vikas Aghadi government led by Shiv Sena. "He tried to discharge the responsibility which the BJP may have given him," Pawar added. Pawar also termed "childish" Raj Thackeray's claim that the ED had raided the family members of Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar, but not the latter's cousin Supriya Sule, who is the daughter of the Pawar senior. Hitting out at the MNS chief, Pawar said that people need not take seriously the statements of a person who makes a statement once in six months or a year.

According to sources, the CBI officials emailed to the SP asking the state police to handover the FIR copies to the central agency. "A team has been formed to probe the incident and will visit the place also. Two arrested accused will be quizzed. The team will meet the family of the deceased girl and will get the details of who had threatened them and also why the body was cremated without any death certificate and post mortem. The CBI officials will also try to collect evidence (if any)," said the CBI sources. The CBI sources also confirmed that DIG CBI Akhilesh Singh will visit Hanskhali on Thursday. Lawyers protest in Calcutta High court; Dhankhar seeks meeting with CM

KOLKATA: West Bengal Governor Jagdeep Dhankhar on Wednesday urged Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee for a meeting during the day in view of the "disturbing scenario" in the precincts of the Calcutta High Court, even as its Chief Justice held urgent discussions with representatives of its three bars to resolve the situation. Some lawyers gathered in front of the court of Justice Abhijit Gangopadhyay on Wednesday morning and they were seen urging others not to attend his court. Justice Gangopadhyay has in the recent past ordered CBI enquiry in at least four cases over alleged irregularities in appointments of teaching and non-teaching staff in state government-aided schools. Several advocates, however, went inside the judge's court to plead their cases before him.

president JP Nadda formed a five-member team comprising UP Lok Sabha MP Rekha Verma, UP minister Baby Rani Maurya, national women wing president Vanathi Srinivasan, Khushbu Sundar, NEC, Maharashtra and Bengal MLA Sreerupa Mitra Chaudhary. Tight security for Hanuman Jayanti procession in Hyd

HYDERABAD: Hyderabad police will make tight security arrangements for the procession to be taken out in the city to mark Hanuman Jayanti on Saturday. Police has chalked out an elaborate security plan for the ensuing procession that draws hordes of devotees. Guidelines were given to all SHOs to be vigilant in law and order, security arrangements, and to coordinate with field level officers of other government departments. City Police Commissioner C.V. Anand on Wednesday chaired

the inter-department coordination meeting for the smooth conclusion of the procession. Officials from Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation R&B, Electricity, Fire Department, EMRI and police officials from Cyberabad and Rachakonda commissionerates attended the meeting. Anand apprised other govt departments on the need for putting up strong barricading, uninterrupted power supply, debris clearing and pruning tree branches along the procession route.

Expenditure on welfare of poor never a burden for Modi govt, says Goyal

NEW DELHI: Union Minister Piyush Goyal on Wednesday said any expenditure for the welfare of the poor people is never a burden for the Central government led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Replying to a query about

the expenditure on free distribution of ration while addressing a press conference here at BJP headquarters, Goyal said: "Let me clarify that any expenditure for the welfare and benefit of the poor is never a burden for the Prime Minister Narendra Modi government. Welfare of the poor was, is and will be our priority."

"It has nothing to do with the election. PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana was announced nearly two years ago under the Atmanirbhar Bharat package when there was no election. Any expenditure made on the poor has never been for electoral gains. It

started when there were no election in sight." Goyal said that 1,000 lakh tonnes of food grains worth Rs 3.40 lakh crore reached 80 crore people in the country. "Access to food security is a fundamental issue and we ensure food to everyone. Lakhs of tonnes of ration reached 80 crore people," Goyal said.

He noted that 'One Nation - One Ration Card' was a vision of the Prime Minister and the government started it to provide ration to 80 crore beneficiaries anywhere in the country with the use of technology. "People have taken their food grains somewhere else instead of their homes through 65 crore portability transactions," he said. He mentioned that the works of the Prime Minister have also been appreciated on the international stage.

HC rejects Varavara's plea for permanent medical bail

EXTENDS TEMPORARY BAIL BY 3 MONTHS

MUMBAI: The Bombay High Court on Wednesday rejected poet-activist Varavara Rao's plea seeking permanent medical bail in the Elgar Parishad-Maoist Links case. A bench of Justices S B Shukre and G A Sanap, however, extended the time for the 83-year-old activist to surrender before the Taloja prison authorities by three months, to enable him to undergo a cataract surgery.

The bench dismissed Rao's application seeking that he be permitted to stay in Hyderabad instead of Mumbai, while out on bail.

The HC also said it had found substance in several claims made by Rao's counsel Anand Grover on the lack of medical facilities in the Taloja prison, located in neighbouring Navi Mumbai, and poor hygiene conditions there. The court, therefore, directed Maharashtra Inspector General of prisons to submit a "candid" report on the state of such facilities at the "Taloja prison in particular," and also in all prisons across the state. The HC directed the IG to submit the report to the court by April 30 this year. "The IG prisons must ensure that henceforth, there remain no grounds for inmates to raise grievances on inadequate health facilities in prisons across the state," the court said.

It also directed the special NIA court to expedite the trial in the Elgar Parishad case, and to conduct the trial proceedings on a day-to-day basis.

Poisonous mushroom toll 13

GUWAHATI

At least 13 people including a child have died in Assam after consuming wild poisonous mushroom, officials said on Wednesday.

Prasanta Dihingia, Superintendent of Assam Medical College and Hospital (AMCH) in Dibrugarh, said most of the people who consumed wild mushroom died while undergoing treatment. He said several others are currently undergoing treatment. Dihingia said 35 people belonging to the tea garden community from eastern Assam's Charaideo, Dibrugarh, Sivasagar and Tinsukia districts were admitted to the AMCH in the last five days as they fell sick after consuming the mushroom. Of the 35 admitted, 13 have died in the last 24 hours. He said that every year, many people fall sick after consuming wild mushroom, and some of them often succumb to their illness.

49 terrorists neutralised in J&K since Jan 1: CRPF

NEW DELHI: A total of 49 terrorists have been killed in Jammu and Kashmir by the security forces since January 1 this year till date, the CRPF officials said here on Wednesday.

They also said that during this period, 71 terrorists have been apprehended while three ultras surrendered. In the month of April, eight terrorists were killed in the operation while 10 were apprehended by the security forces including the CRPF. The officials also said that during the recent operations, one LeT terrorist was killed in Anantnag district on April 9, two foreign terrorists were killed in Srinagar on April 10 while two including one foreign terrorist were killed on April 11 in Jammu and Kashmir. They further informed that as many as 311 insurgents were apprehended in the northeast while 55 have surrendered during this period. Referring to the Left Wing Extremism areas, the officials said that six Maoists have been killed while 183 were nabbed and 204 have surrendered since January 1 till date.
