MGM to do...
The goof-up not only affected the 46 students who failed in practical exams but also impacted the result and merit of all the students of the batch, a senior faculty member said. The initial request of the medical college with the MPMSI to revise the marks has been rejected by the medical university and asked the college to send an affidavit mentioning the goof-up.

SC: How many...
Murugan allegedly made derogatory remarks with an intention to breach public peace and tranquillity and on a complaint of DMK member, police registered a case against him. Murugan was arrested in October 2021.

The Madras High Court had in November 2021 granted bail to Murugan, however, later a division bench of the High Court cancelled his bail. In 2022, the apex court had granted interim bail to Murugan.

RaGa has links...
It was Prime Minister Narendra Modi who developed Amethi and the people of the city will always bless him. "The Union Minister also said the BJP workers know that the Gandhi family will come to contest the elections from Amethi. "Prime Minister Narendra Modi sends ration to 19 lakh citizens in Amethi Lok Sabha constituency. If the Gandhi family is against Narendra Modi, it will say to the 19 lakh citizens who are getting free ration? In the 2019 Lok Sabha elections, Smriti Irani had defeated Rahul Gandhi in Amethi.

SIT to attach assets...
The Additional Commissioner of Police, Bairagarh Anil Shukla is taking the steps to block all bank accounts of absconding accused and to freeze them. Till date, Rs 6.80 crore has been attached.

At the same time, Crime Branch help is being taken to collect the information of mobile phones of absconding accused and their family members. Already look out notices have been issued against Sunil Kumar Gupta and Rakesh Singh Rajput. SIT members are searching absconding accused. They have also traced and sequestered Rs 19.48 crores of variety and get them deposited in other bank accounts in forged manner.

Total three arrests have been made in the case and those arrested includes Kumar Mayank, Ex Manager of Axis Bank (Pune), Ramkumar Raghuvansi and Dalit Sangh (Subagpur) member Sunil Raghuvansi. A cash of Rs 8,60,000 was seized from Kumar Mayank. Along with this Rs 15,68, 348 were frozen from SBI Account followed by Rs 94,492 from Jeevan Finance Bank, Rs 1,000 from Axis Bank and Rs 34,71,375 from RBL account.

Pragya Thakur ill...
The court is recording statements of the accused under section 313 (where the accused personally explains any circumstances appearing in the evidence against him) of the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPc). The medical certificate annexed with the compliance report states that a doctor visited Thakur's house in Bhopal, verified her condition, and advised her to rest as mentioned in the certificate issued by her hospital, it noted. "Considering the aforesaid report, it can be said that accused Number 1 (Thakur) is ill and the doctor has advised her bed rest," the court stated.

The court also asked the agency to bring to its notice immediately any more information about the health of the accused.

The court had on March 11 issued a bailable warrant against Thakur for failing to attend the proceedings, despite being specially directed to appear. On March 22, the warrant was cancelled after Thakur appeared before the court. However, she has since been seeking exemption from personal appearance, citing her health condition. Six people were killed and over 100 injured when an explosive device strapped on a motorcycle went off near a mosque in Malegaon, a town about 200 km from Mumbai in north Maharashtra, on September 29, 2008. The Anti Terror Squad (ATS), Maharashtra was probing the case initially before it was transferred to the NIA in 2011.

Cong files complaint to EC against PM's remarks on its poll manifesto

NEW DELHI
The Congress complained to the Election Commission (EC) on Monday against Prime Minister Narendra Modi's remarks targeting the Lok Sabha poll manifesto with that of the Muslim League. A delegation of Congress leaders met EC officials and raised several issues, including the use of pictures and large cutouts of the prime minister in government buildings and colleges and demanded that those be removed to maintain a level playing field in the upcoming parliamentary election. Congress general secretary Jairam Ramesh said the party has filed a complaint against Modi for making comments against it, alleging that its manifesto attempts to divide the country and promote pre-judicial ideology of the Muslim League. The prime minister has said in his election rallies that the Congress has indulged in pre-judicially committing such crimes.

TMC leaders were detained by the Delhi Police on Monday while they were holding a dharna outside the Election Commission's office, demanding that the chiefs of CBI, NIA, ED and Income Tax Department be changed.

The Mamata Banerjee-led party has been alleging that the central probe agencies - the Enforcement Directorate (ED), the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), the National Investigation Agency (NIA) and the Income Tax (IT) Department - have been targeting opposition parties at the behest of the BJP-led Centre.

EXCISE POLICY ED quizzes Kejri's PA, AAP MLA Pathak

NEW DELHI
The Enforcement Directorate on Monday questioned Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's personal secretary Bibhav and AAP MLA Durgesh Pathak in the excise policy-linked money laundering case, officials said.

Their statement is being recorded under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), they said. Both of them have been questioned in this case earlier too by the ED. Sources said Kumar's questioning was essential in connection with the engagements of Kejriwal. The 55-year-old CM, also the national convener of the AAP, was arrested by the court in this case last month. He is currently lodged in the Tihar Jail under judicial custody.

The agency had alleged in its earlier charge sheets that at least 36 accused, including former Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and Kumar, "destroyed, used or changed" 170 phones to conceal evidence of "kickbacks" worth thousands of crores of rupees in the alleged scam.

SC: Judiciary has to be 'flag bearer' & march with nation

NEW DELHI
Observing that the judiciary has to be the "flag bearer" and march with the nation, the Supreme Court on Monday pulled up the Indian Coast Guard (ICG) over the treatment meted out to a woman who was discharged as a short service commission officer in 2021, and ordered the maritime force to re-induct her.

Coming down hard on the ICG for resisting grant of permanent commission to women officers, a bench headed by Chief Justice D V Chandrachud referred to the top court's verdicts on grant of permanent commission to women officers in the Army, Air Force and Navy and said that the discrimination has to end.

Court denies interim bail to K Kavitha

A Delhi court on Monday denied interim bail to BRS leader K Kavitha, arrested in a money laundering case linked to the alleged Delhi excise policy scam, saying prima facie she is not only destroyed evidence but was also instrumental in influencing witnesses and there is "every likelihood" of her continuing to do so in case the relief is granted. Kavitha had approached the court for interim bail, claiming her 18-year-old son has exams and needs her "moral and emotional support".

"From the material placed before this court, it appears that the Applicant is not only engaged in destruction of material evidence by formatting her phones before joining the investigation and after being served with notice requiring her to do so, along with her digital devices, which stands established by way of the forensic report in this regard, but also has been instrumental in influencing witnesses and there is every likelihood of her continuing to do so in case the relief prayed for is granted to her," Special Judge Kavari Baweja said. The judge said Kavitha was stated to be highly educated, and by no standards can be said to a vulnerable woman who could be made a scapegoat for committing the alleged offences. She is undoubtedly a "well-educated" and "well-placed woman in the society".

Received threat letter from LeT on NRC: Union Minister Shantamu Thakur

KOLKATA: The Union Minister of State for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Shantamu Thakur, claimed on Monday that he received a threat letter from the terror outfit Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) over the National Register of Citizens (NRC). Speaking to mediapersons here, Thakur, whom the BJP has nominated in the Bangalor Lok Sabha seat in North 24 Parganas district, claimed that the threat letter reportedly sent by the LeT was written in Bangla.

The letter said if people from the Muslim community in West Bengal suffer because of the implementation of NRC, the entire country will burn, Thakur claimed. The letter also threatened to blow up the Thakurbari in Bangaon, the ancestral residence of the Union Minister which is also a religious centre for the Matua community.

DEFAMATION CASE SC dismisses Sanjay Singh's plea against Gujarat HC's order

The Supreme Court on Monday dismissed a plea filed by AAP leader Sanjay Singh challenging an order of the Gujarat High Court which refused to quash summons issued against him in a defamation case filed by his alleged comments on Prime Minister Narendra Modi's educational qualification. The bench said the high court had already observed in its order that the contents available to the parties were kept open and the trial judge would not be influenced by any observations made in the order.

The high court had on February 16 dismissed the pleas by Singh and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal seeking quashing of the summons issued against them in the defamation case. Kejriwal and Singh had challenged in the high court the summons issued by a trial court in the case filed by the Gujarat University and the subsequent order of the sessions court dismissing their revision applications against the summons.

36 shops gutted as fire breaks out in Ganjiya temple complex

NAINITAL
Nearly three dozen shops were burned down on Monday in a fire in the famous Ganjiya temple complex in Rannagar here, police said. There is no report of any loss of life in the incident, they said, adding that the fire broke out at a shop selling 'prasad' as hawkers were preparing for the Navratri starting Tuesday. It soon spread to around 35 adjacent shops and reduced them to ashes, Rannagar Station House Officer (SHO) Arun Kumar said. "The shops were gutted and the fire spread quickly," he said. It took local people and fire department personnel hours to douse the flames, he said.

Former BRS MLA's son arrested

HYDERABAD: A former BRS MLA's son, who was absconding in connection with a road accident case here since December last year was arrested, Hyderabad police said on Monday. Mohammed Aamir Raheel, son of former Bodhan MLA Mohammed Shaked Aamir, the main accused in the case, who had left the country immediately after committing the offence, surrendered before the police at Panjagutta police station on Sunday, as per the order of the Telangana High Court.

Cong MLA appears before ED

RANCHI: Jharkhand Congress MLA Amba Prasad on Monday appeared before the Enforcement Directorate for questioning in an alleged money laundering case. Prasad entered the ED office here around 2.30 pm. The 36-year-old Prasad, who represents Bargaon in Jharkhand assembly, had been asked to depose on April 4 by the ED to record her statement under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), officials sources said. But, the MLA did not turn up citing medical issues.

BJP worker run over by bus after crashing into Union minister's car door

A BJP worker riding a motorcycle was run over by a bus after he crashed into the open door of a car belonging to Union Minister State for Agriculture Shobha Karandlaje and fell down during an election campaign at Kir Puram here on Monday. Karandlaje is contesting the Lok Sabha polls from Bengaluru North constituency and Prakash was following her convoy during her election campaign. Sources said the minister was inside the car. As soon as the driver of her car was opened, Prakash crashed into it and fell down. The minister said he was run over by a bus coming from behind.

The deceased, identified as Prakash died on the spot in the incident that occurred near Ganesh Temple in the locality
killing him instantaneously. It was not known if it was Karandlaje who opened the door or someone else. Later speaking to reporters, she mourned Prakash's death. "We all are pained. Prakash was our dedicated worker, who used to be with us round-the-clock. We are with his family. We will pay compensation from our party fund," the Minister told reporters.

Can't stop Mahua from defending herself in public, says HC

The Delhi High Court on Monday said TMC leader Mahua Moitra cannot be prevented from defending herself against allegations made by an estranged friend in public domain as long as her statements are not objectively false. Dehrajai has filed a lawsuit against Moitra seeking damages of Rs 2 crore for making certain allegedly defamatory statements against him in the backdrop of the cash-for-query row.

The court made the oral observation while dealing with a plea by lawyer Jay Anant Dehrajai seeking an interim injunction to stop the expelled Lok Sabha MP from making "defamatory" statements against him

Moitra was expelled from the Lok Sabha on December 8 following accusations by the plaintiff that she took bribes from businessman and Hiranandani Group CEO Darshan Hiranandani to ask questions in Parliament.
