RGPV's absconding...

Enforcement Directorate (ED), on September 2, had conducted searches and frozen funds to the tune of Rs 190 crore as part of a money laundering probe into alleged irregularities at RGPV, Bhopal.

The raids were carried out on Monday at premises in Bhopal, and Sohagpur and Pipariya in Narmadapuram district, and Ranchi and Bokaro in Jharkhand. The searches covered the residential premises of the key persons of the university including that of ex-Vice Chancellor (Dr Sunil Kumar), ex-registrar and ex-finance controller.

Main accused shifted to...

He said that the main accused of stone pelting case Haji Shahzad Ali has been transferred to Central Jail Bhopal.

While many have been sent to Central Jail Sagar, Central Jail Gwalior and Central Jail Satna, he said.

Two more accused of the case has been arrested by the Chhatrapati police.

CSP Aman Mishra informed that till date 45 accused of the case have been arrested. The two accused arrested were Irfan Rayen and one minor is present. They were roaming in the city after changing their group to mislead the police.

Cops tried to bribe us to...

After the incident came to light, protests erupted across the state, with people from various sectors demanding justice for the victim.

Kolhapur Police arrested a civic volunteer for allegedly being involved in the rape and murder of the trainee doctor.

The Calcutta High Court ordered the case to be handed over to the CBI in the second week of August. Later, the court ordered the transfer of the probe into the alleged financial irregularities at the hospital from a state-constituted Special Investigation Team (SIT) to the central agency.

On Monday, the CBI arrested the former principal of RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, Dr Sandip Ghosh, in connection with alleged financial misconduct at the establishment.

NCPDR seeks action against...

Omkar Singh, a member of NCPDR, who headed the inspection drive, told IANS on Thursday that the Madrasa was operating on the license of a private school.

"The permission was granted to enroll students up to Class 8 but students of 9th and 10th standards were found enrolled in Madrasa. It wasn't an educational institution but a religious institution where children are being imparted Islamic religious teachings," Singh said.

He further said that many children enrolled in Madrasa were from other states, whereas the government's guidelines do not allow children from other states.

"The classes for students are being conducted only for three hours, while the government rules say classes would be run for 6 hours a day. An Ibaadat-gah (place of worship for Muslims) was also found in the campus. That is also against the rules," Singh added.

He further stated that the Commission has submitted its report to the state government and has recommended immediate action against the Madrasa.

Responding to NCPDR's claims, School Education

Minister in Madhya Pradesh government, Uday Pratap Singh, said that action would be initiated against Madrasa.

"Inspections are being carried out in Madrasas operating across Madhya Pradesh. The registration of 56 Madrasas has been cancelled," the minister told IANS.

Notably, Russia and Ukraine have been engaged in a conflict since February 2022. India has called for dialogue and diplomacy to resolve the conflict.

Poker, rummy games of...

The primary legal issue before the court was whether poker and rummy could be classified as gambling or recognized as games of skill.

The petitioner's counsel argued that the denial by the DCP was based on conjecture, with no factual basis for the assumption that allowing such games would disturb peace or encourage gambling. It was argued that such assumptions do not constitute a valid legal ground for refusing permission.

The bench stressed that the authorities should thoroughly examine the matter and not deny permission based on conjecture alone. The court ruled that refusal of permission on the basis of mere speculation by the concerned officer cannot be sustained. The court further said that refusal to allow recreational gaming activities must be supported by concrete facts presented by the officer. Granting permission to operate poker and rummy gaming units would not prevent the authorities from monitoring the premises for illegal gambling activities.

KOLKATA RAPE-MURDER: CBI gets clues about Sandip's letter

Ghosh ordered hospital renovation after incident

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) probing the rape and murder of a woman doctor at R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital has found a crucial document showing that former principal Sandip Ghosh gave instructions to the state public works department (PWD) to conduct renovation in areas adjacent to the scene of the crime a year after the victim's body was recovered.

The body of the victim was recovered on the morning of August 9 from the seminar room within the hospital premises.

Sources said the investigating officials secured a crucial document showing that Ghosh issued the permission letter to state PWD to conduct renovation work in a room

and toilet adjacent to the seminar hall, which is the scene of the crime.

The investigating officials have accessed that permission letter which bears the signature of Ghosh and is dated August 10, sources said.

Sources said that initially it was perceived that the instruction to PWD to start the renovation work was given by an administrative official of RG Kar under the instruction of Ghosh.

On August 13 evening, just hours after a division bench of Calcutta High Court ordered CBI to take over the rape and investigation probe from Kolkata Police, the state PWD staff attempted the renovation work at a room adjacent to the seminar hall from where the body of the victim was recovered on the morning of August 9.

HARYANA ASSEMBLY ELECTION

BJPs first list of candidates triggers revolt across state

The first list of its 67 candidates released by the ruling BJP for the upcoming October 5 assembly election in Haryana has triggered a rebellion within the party across the state with several of its leaders resigning or announcing to fight independently.

The revolt erupted Wednesday night itself immediately after the release of BJP's list by some of the sitting MLAs who were denied ticket. Ratiati's sitting MLA Laxman Napa, former OBC president Karan Dev Kamboj and Cabinet Minister Chaudhary were among the first to come out in open to protest against the list.

Napa joined Congress along with his supporters on Thursday night.

By Thursday, the rebels' list had increased with party's

former MLA Savitri Jindal, BJP Kisan Morcha president Sukhvinder Mandi, former minister Bishambar Valmiki and state vice president G L Sharma also protesting against their exclusion from the list.

Ranjit Chaudhary who had joined BJP during the Lok Sabha elections and unsuccessfully contested from Hissar has resigned from his ministerial position and has announced he would contest from Ranina.

Former MLA Bachan Singh Arya resigned from the party and said he would contest as an independent, after the party fielded JJP turnout from Narnauda Ram Ram Gautam, from Safidon segment. Former minister Kavita Jain, who reportedly broke down after being denied the ticket last night, has also given a three-day ultimatum.

J&K polls: After Ganderbal, Omar files nomination from Budgam

National Conference (NC) vice-president Omar Abdullah on Thursday filed his nomination papers to contest the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly polls from Budgam.

"Omar Abdullah filed his nomination for the Budgam constituency for the upcoming Jammu and Kashmir Assembly polls," an NC spokesperson said here.

Abdullah was accompanied by senior NC leaders Aga Ruhullah Mehdi, Aga Mehmod, party treasurer Shammi Oberoi and provincial secretary Shaikat Mir.

The former Jammu and Kashmir chief minister will contest the polls from two constituencies. He filed his papers from the family bastion of Ganderbal on Wednesday.

India ranks 7th in global study on sleep deprivation

A recent study by Onebed has revealed that India ranks seventh among the countries with the most challenges in sleep environments. The study analyzed a variety of factors, including average hours of sleep per night, air quality, noise pollution, stress levels, and the frequency of Google searches for "sleep deprivation" and "insomnia remedies" to determine how these elements impact

sleep quality globally. India's position in the study highlights significant challenges that contribute to poor sleep quality across the country. With a composite score of 0.79, India experiences the highest



pollution levels among the top 10 countries, measured at 78.40. Additionally, the country's stress level is also noted at 7.40, further exacerbating sleep difficulties. The study also found that India has the second-highest number of monthly Google searches for both "sleep deprivation" and "insomnia remedies," second only to the United States. This indicates a widespread concern about sleep issues among the Indian population.

Telangana: Six Maoists killed in exchange of fire with police

Six cadres of the outlawed CPI (Maoist) including two women were killed after an exchange of fire between the ultras and police in Bhadrachalam district of Telangana on Thursday, police said.

Two commandos of the Greyhounds, the elite anti-naxal force of Telangana Police, were also injured in the exchange of fire and were shifted to a hospital and their condition is out of danger, they said. The exchange of fire took place at around 6.45 am in the forest area of Mochi village under Karakagudem police station limits when the armed CPI (Maoist) cadres opened fire indiscriminately on the police party which was on patrol, a release from police said.

After warning the Maoist cadres to stop fire and in self-defence, as the firing from the Maoists did not stop, the police party also returned fire. After the firing stopped from CPI (Maoist) armed cadres, the police party searched the area and found six bodies, clad in olive green clothes, it said. The six dead were CPI (Maoist) cadres of Bhadrachalam divisional committee, the release said.
