Item no. 1 – Adoption of financial statements

To consider and adopt the audited financial statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2026 and the reports of the Board of Directors (“the Board”) and auditors thereon.

Item no. 2 – Appointment of a director in place of Mr. Arvind Kataria who retires by rotation

To appoint a director in place of Mr. Arvind Kataria (Director) (DIN: 00088771), who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-appointment.

Special Business:

Item no. 3 – Ratification of Cost Auditor’s Remuneration

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 148(3) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force) and the Companies (Audit and Auditors) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, the Company hereby ratifies the remuneration of Rs. 65,000/- (Rupees Sixty-Five Thousand only) plus applicable taxes, travel and actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred in connection with the audit, payable to M/s. M. P. Turakhia & Associates, Cost Accountants, Indore (Firm Registration No. 000417), who are appointed as Cost Auditors to conduct the audit of cost records maintained by the Company for the financial year 2026 -27.”

NOTES:

1. Pursuant to Section 105 of the Companies Act, 2013, a person can act as proxy on behalf of members not exceeding 50 and holding in the aggregate not more than 10% of the total share capital of the Company carrying voting rights. A Member holding more than 10% of the total share capital of the company carrying voting rights may appoint a single person as proxy and such person shall not act as a proxy for any other person or shareholder.
The instrument appointing proxy in order to be effective should be duly stamped, completed and signed and should be deposited at the Registered Office of the Company not later than 48 hours before the time fixed for the meeting. A Proxy Form is annexed to this report. Proxies submitted on behalf of limited companies, societies, etc., must be supported by an appropriate resolution/authority, as applicable.

 - i. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Act read with The Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, a member may exercise his right to vote by electronic means (e-voting) in respect of the resolutions contained in this notice.
 - ii. The Company is providing e-voting facility to its members to enable them to cast their votes electronically. The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") as the Authorized Agency to provide e-voting facilities.
 - iii. The Board of Directors has appointed CS Shweta Garg, Company Secretary in whole time practice, Indore with Membership No. FCS 5501 and Certificate of Practice No. 4984 as the Scrutinizer, for conducting the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
 - iv. Members are requested to carefully read the instructions for e-voting before casting their vote.
 - v. The e-voting facility will be available during the following voting period after which the portal will be blocked and shall not be available for e-voting:

- vi. The cut-off date for the purpose of e-voting is 25th September, 2026.

THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:

- (i) The voting period begins at 9:00 a.m. (IST) on 27th September, 2026 and ends at 05:00 p.m. (IST) on 29th September, 2026. During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of 25th September, 2026 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- (iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- (iv) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants.
